Georgia Kathleen “Kay” Samples Thompson passed away on Sunday, Feb. 13, 2011.

She was preceded in death by her husband Pearce J. Thompson. She is survived by her son Steve Thompson and his wife Donna, two granddaughters Katie Irene Bowers and Jenny Kathleen Stalnaker, a Great-Granddaughter Liberty Stalnaker, a brother Howard Gardner, and several sisters-in-law, nieces and nephews. Kathleen was a native of Alpharetta, a member of the Alpharetta First United Methodist Church, an Honor Graduate of Milton High School class of 1940, and earned a scholarship to West Georgia College. As a military wife, she traveled the world and has been on every continent except Australia and Antarctica. She was a charter member of the Alpharetta Garden Club and a long time member of the Alpharetta Historical Society and past president of each. She was one of the first ladies to become a Lion Club member. Whether it was working the polls, or teaching kindergarten, or providing Meals-on-Wheels, she was always involved and contributing to the community. Kathleen was presented the Community Leader Award for outstanding service to the Roswell-Alpharetta Community by the American Association of University Women.
