



Gerri Irick LeCrone

May 17, 1943 - June 8, 2012

Gerri Irick LeCrone died Friday, June 8th, 2012 at the age of 69 from cancer, less than two months from her 40th wedding anniversary.

Mrs. LeCrone is survived by two children: Robin Scott and Kip LeCrone, four grandchildren: Randi Kay, Jennifer, Tarah and Reece and two great grandchildren: Scout and Atticus.

From a young age, Mrs. LeCrone displayed her skill as an artist. She excelled at painting in both water color and oil. After graduating Bishop McGuinness High School in Oklahoma City as Gerri Irick, she was offered an art scholarship to the Kansas City Art Institute. She met her best-friend-to-be, Kerry LeCrone, in 1970 and married him two years later. She worked and raised her children and used her artistic talents gardening and decorating until the children were grown. She then turned her talents to designing and creating unique and beautiful jewelry. Mrs. LeCrone has sold her jewelry to customers all over the world, including many celebrities. In 2008 she began donating the proceeds from her sales to her favorite charities. She fell in her home on March 8th and was diagnosed with cancer at the hospital.
