In her experience as a librarian, she experienced the transition from catalogues to computers while becoming an expert in her field. After retirement, she traveled the world and spent her winters in Florida. She was active at St. Peter & St Paul United Church, Cincinnati Woman's Club, volunteering for Meals on Wheels, and taking classes at University of

Cincinnati. She made many afghan blankets in her spare time and was an avid reader. She was truly a lifelong learner. She was an inspiration to everyone she met and loved all the family pets.
