Gregory Charles Thomson, age 50, resided in Alpharetta, Georgia. Greg passed away on Tuesday, January 3, 2017. He is survived by his children, Charlie and Susanne, his brother, Mark and his parents, Ron and Lorraine.

Greg graduated High School from The Governor's Academy in Byfield, MA and received his BS in Manufacturing Systems Engineering from Worcester Polytechnic Institute in Worcester, MA. Greg was a member of the Alpha Chi Rho Fraternity. He passionately worked in his dream career and company as an Advisory Manager in the Cyber Risk practice of Deloitte.

Greg was an active member of Alpharetta First United Methodist Church for 14 years. He was on the Church Council, a leader in the New Visions Sunday School Class and led mission trips to Romania in support of SPeR Missio Link International, helping young women under the age of 18 who had suffered serious abuse by providing a home and needed support. He was also a participant in many Christian Men's groups and a member of the Emmaus Community.
