



Mrs. Greselda "Doodlebug" Harrison

May 19, 1938 - October 5, 2014

Eleanor Greselda Harrison, 76, of Cumming, GA passed away on October 5, 2014 at her home surrounded by her family. Fondly known as "Doodlebug," she was born in Dallas, GA and lived in Alpharetta, GA for the majority of her life before moving to Cumming, GA. Greselda was the daughter of Buford and Corine Asherbranner (both predeceased) and was one of four children and is survived by Gerald Asherbranner and Gwendolyn and Sonny Wright and predeceased by Bobby Asherbranner. Greselda married Deloyd Harrison on June 11, 1955 and they recently celebrated their 59th wedding anniversary. Known as "Greselda" or "Doodlebug," she was the friendly face of the Alpharetta Florist and then GAMP'S Florist for almost half a century. Her voice would resonate over the telephone, "Good Afternoon, How may I help you?" Whether at the florist, attending church, or just around town, she never met a stranger and always projected a positive attitude and demeanor. Greselda was an extremely active member of the Alpharetta PTA, American Legion Auxiliary, and other social organizations in the 1970's. She is survived by: two daughters, Charlotte and Tim Nolan of Cumming and Angela Roberts of Holly Springs; three granddaughters, Jessica Long of Holly Springs, Kayla and Jason Reynolds of Ball ground, and Kimberly and Jason Brown of Wake Forest, NC; great-grandchildren Kallie and Colton Reynolds; uncle Virgin Asherbranner; nephews Chris Wright and Brian Asherbranner; and many cousins. Referred to as "Mimi" by her grandchildren, she was always loving, generous, and nurturing. Greselda was a long-time, active member of

Bethany Baptist Church. In addition to her various family members, church members, and fiction kin, she will be greatly missed by the many individuals that crossed her path during her 76 years. Greselda passed after a short battle with cancer and was showered with numerous cards and sentiments reminding her and her family of the many thoughts, prayers, and unconditional love that was shown toward her until the very end.
