TEAGUE, JR., H. HENRY - Hoyt Henry Teague, Jr. 69 of Marietta, Georgia, died February 25, 2006. A native of Atlanta, he lived most of his life in Atlanta; was the son of the late Sara M. Upshaw. He is survived by his wife Carole D. Teague, son and daughter-in-law, Adam and Kathy Teague, and daughter, Mason A. Teague. He is a 1954 Sylvan Hills High School graduate and in 1960, Henry received his Masters degree in Architecture from Georgia Tech. As president of FABRAP and chief architect with Rosser International, Henry served as project manager or designer on selected sports projects for more than 30 years. He participated in planning and design reviews of all Rosser sports projects. His credits include civic stadiums (football, baseball and multi-purpose), collegiate football stadiums, multi-purpose enclosed stadiums/arenas and recreational facilities. A few of his local designs are Georgia State University Urban Life Center, The Atlanta Cyclorama, Georgia Dome, 1996 Olympic Stadium, Turner Field and Atlanta Fulton County Stadium.
