Ms. Halle Grace Scott, 19 years of Dunwoody and a sophomore at the University of Georgia died on the evening of April 27, 2016 from injuries sustained in a tragic auto accident. She is survived by her loving parents, Stephen and Valerie Scott; older brother, William Sullivan Scott; grandmothers, Grace Feckoury and Darleene Scott; along with several aunts, uncles and cousins. Halle was an excellent student at UGA and was a member of Tri Delta Sorority. She was an active member of Dunwoody United Methodist Church, having been baptized, confirmed and served on mission trips both local and abroad. Halle was a part of the graduating class of 2014 from Dunwoody High School where she participated in cheerleading Fellowship of Christian Athletes and National Honor Society. She also served with various charities through her membership with National Charity League, Dunwoody. Halle had an infectious smile that would light up any room and was a welcoming person who was kind and had a gracious spirit. We are grateful for her time on earth and the joy she gave us. She will be greatly missed.
