May 14, 1957 - April 25, 2012

Ms. Helen Ayiteyfo, nee Leibbrandt, was born May 14, 1957 in Swaziland to Dr. Victor Sydney Leibbrandt and the late Kelinah Mdluli Leibbrandt. She immigrated to Accra, Ghana with her husband, Daniel Ayiteyfo. From there they moved to Toronto, Canada, and eventually settled in Atlanta, Georgia. She passed away on April 25, 2012 at her home in Roswell, Georgia.

Helen attended Evelyn Baring High School in Nhlngano, Swaziland, and graduated from Georgia State University with a Business of Administration degree. She was well-known in her community for her volunteer work especially her work with homeless women. Helen was recognized as an unsung heroine by the National Coalition of One Hundred Black Women.
