August 15, 1909 - August 20, 2005

Mr. Henry Burton Carroll, 96, of Roswell, died August 20, 2005. Mr. Carroll was a retired Captain with the Fulton County Sheriff's Dept. where he served for 50 years. He was a WWII veteran, a Mason and a member of the Yaarab Shrine, where he was recently honored as the oldest living member of the Yaarab Shrine Motor Corp. He was preceded in death by his wife, Kate Jones Carroll and James (Jimmy) Jackson, MIA, U.S. Marines, Vietnam-1969, a young man reared, nurtured and loved by the Carroll's. Surviving are 3 nieces and one nephew, and several grand nieces and nephews. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, August 23, at 2:00 p.m. in the funeral home chapel.
