



Henry Delcamp Dolive, Sr.

December 19, 1914 - February 11, 2014

A service honoring the life of Henry Delcamp Dolive, Sr. of Atlanta, Georgia will be held at Northside Chapel Funeral Directors, 12050 Crabapple Road, Roswell, GA 30075 on Monday, February 17, 2014 at 2:00pm. Visitation at 1:00pm will precede the service, with interment at Arlington Cemetery in Sandy Springs following the memorial service.

Henry was born in Jacksonville, Florida, but moved to Atlanta at five years old. As a young man he graduated from Tech High, and attended Georgia Tech. Henry was a World War II veteran, serving in the Army of the United States (Pacific Theatre of Operations) in the 806 Tank Destroyer Battalion. He was preceded in death by his wife of 73 years, Margaret Bowen Cathcart Dolive; and by his sister, Marcellite Dolive Baker, and brothers James, William, and Earl Dolive, and one granddaughter, Cheri Dolive. He is survived by six children and their spouses: Hank Dolive (Donna), John Dolive (Mary), Cathy Weiss (Terry), Mark Dolive (Juanita), Daniel Dolive (Melanie), and Francie Dolive; twelve grandchildren, and fifteen great grandchildren. Henry was a member of Mt. Vernon Baptist Church, and was a devoted and beloved child of his Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Henry was an inspiration to all who knew him, and exemplified the words in 1st Corinthians, Chapter 13; "Love is patient, love is kind...love never ends."
