



## Henry Lamar "Shack" Shacklett

November 5, 1930 - February 6, 2013

Lamar Shacklett, age 82, of Alpharetta GA, passed away on Wednesday, February 6, 2013. Lamar was born in Atlanta GA and graduated from Decatur Boys High school. He later attended Auburn University as well as Georgia State University. Lamar served in the United States Navy during the Korean War on board both the USS Boxer destroyer as well as the USS Yorktown aircraft carrier. He worked several different jobs after his service, eventually working as CFO of the newly formed Brake-O Corporation. In the early 70's he began working for the Southern Company as a Senior Accountant/Analysis for Georgia Power division until his retirement in 1995.

Lamar was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Alpharetta where he served as an usher for many years as well as leader for the youth programs. Lamar also served as troop leader for the Cub Scouts as well as the Boy Scouts of America for many years. He was active in coaching little league baseball in Alpharetta. Lamar was extremely active in the Alpharetta Lions club where he served as President for several years.

Lamar was predeceased by his wife Billie W. Shacklett, his father and mother Henry L. Shacklett Sr. and Martha Edwards Schwartzwalder, his daughter Billie Lynn Shacklett Been and his brother Knox B. Shacklett. He is survived by his son Hank Shacklett of Canton GA; Son-In Law, Andy Been of Atlanta GA; Grandchildren, Alexandra & Camden Shacklett of Canton GA, Sara Lynn & Hanna Been of Atlanta GA; Brother and Sister in Law, David & Toni Shacklett of San Antonio TX.; nieces and nephews.
