July 15, 1920 - March 29, 2011

Mr. Herman c. Hendrix, 90, of Woodstock, died March 29, 2011. Born in Nelson, GA to Hollie and Bertha Roper Hendrix, he was a partner in the City Barber Shop in Alpharetta for many years, a longtime member and deacon at the Providence Baptist Church, and was twice awarded the Purple Heart while serving in the Army during WWII. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mae Belle Woodall Hendrix. He is survived by his children, Larry T. Hendrix and his wife Bonnie of Canton and Wynette G. Hutson and her husband Sam of Woodstock; brother Herbert Hendrix and his wife Karen of Tifton; 5 grandchildren and 6 great grand children, several nieces and nephews.
