Herman A. Hampel age 88 of Milton, GA. passed away on December 14, 2018. Mr. Hampel was born on December 21, 1929 in St. Louis MO and served in the Marine Corps. during the Korean War. He attended Washington University in St. Louis and received his Bachelor's Degree in Architectural Engineering in 1957. He had a successful career in Structural Engineering with several large firms until his retirement in 1991 from Equitable Real Estate in their Development and Construction Dept. with the title of Regional Manager Construction. Herman was an active member of the Alpharetta First United Methodist Church in recent years, serving on the Board of Trustees and as a member of the Retired Men's Group who worked on projects within the church.
