Rev. Dr. Herman T. Williams, 73 of Alpharetta, passed away on Wednesday, October 1, 2014 from brain cancer. He was born in Eastman, GA on October 13, 1940 to the late Harmie and Bell Upshaw Williams. Herman was baptized, ordained and married at the Pleasant Hill Baptist Church in Cadwell, GA. He graduated from Cadwell High School in 1958, Brewton Parker College, Georgia College, The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and Luther Rice Seminary. He pastored churches in Georgia and Kentucky. He served on the staff of Brewton Parker College in Mt. Vernon, GA. and with the Georgia Baptist Convention for ten years. His last pastorate was Waleska First Baptist Church in Waleska, GA. He is predeceased by his parents and father and mother-in-law, Charlie and Virginia Phillips. He is survived by his wife, Sandra Phillips Williams; son and daughter-in-law, Charles Matthew Williams and Karen Carter Williams; sister, Nevo Lane of Dublin, GA.; sister-in-law, Sadie Etris; brother-in-law, Jerry Phillips; three nephews, many cousins and pet "Maria."
