



Mr. Hugh Everett Jeffery Sr.

January 9, 1922 - May 5, 2014

Hugh Everett Jeffery passed away on May 5, 2014 at the Halcyon Hospice facility in Atlanta, GA. Mr. Jeffery, the son of Fred and Lucy, was born January 4, 1922 in Chandler OK and spent most of his early days in Wewoka, OK. It was there that he met his wife, Ada Ovadeen Knight, who he married in Clinton, OK while on leave from the Navy after returning from tours in North Africa and Italy. Completing 12 years in the United States Navy, Hugh went to work for Hughes Aircraft Company in southern California and retired after 28 years. While enjoying retirement he served as full time evangelist for the church in Lake Isabella, CA and then worked with the church in Bentonville, AR. He also served as an elder in three different churches and faithfully served His God until his departure from this life. He was a member of the church of Christ in Roswell, GA.

Mr. Jeffery had six brothers and sisters (all deceased) and is survived by Ada Jeffery, his beloved wife of 69 years.
