



## Mr. Jack Morton

February 5, 1941 - October 21, 2018

Jack Morton age 77, a lifelong resident of Alpharetta, passed away on October 21, 2018. He is survived by his loving wife of 56 years, Marjorie Pruitt Morton, three sons, Ken (Julie) Morton of Milton, Kevin J. 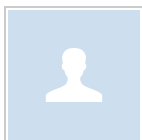
