Jackie Graff of Roswell, Georgia passed away Monday, December, 7 at her home surrounded by her family. Born in Athens, Georgia and raised in Aiken, South Carolina, Jackie attended nursing school and spent more than 40 years at Northside Hospital in Atlanta. Jackie parlayed her career experience, culinary mastery and passion for wellness into pursuing a second career as co-founder of the Graff Academy of Raw Food Education with her husband Gideon. Together they became accomplished educators and it became her mission to teach, inspire and guide her students to success in the practice of wellness through nutrition and healthy living. Jackie and Gideon traveled the US and Canada extensively, teaching classes and small group instruction which grew into a community of friends and constituents that admired Jackie. Jackie's charm, wisdom, creativity and quick-witted humor were infectious among those who met her and she was truly one to never meet a stranger. Known as "Nana" to her grandchildren, her caring and nurturing ways brought her much love and affection among her family, friends and former students around the world. Her grandchildren were a priority in her life and she never missed an opportunity to spend time with them including two in Roswell, four in Israel and one in England.

Jackie is survived by her husband of 30 years Gideon Graff, brothers David Meadow of Columbia, South Carolina and Robert Meadow of New York City; two daughters - Shelly Puckett Williams and her husband Bill of Roswell,
