James F. Buckle Jr., 83, of Roswell died on Saturday Feb. 19, 2011. He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Anna Mae, and four children: Anne Buckle (James Shipman) of Davenport, Fl., James F. Buckle III of Villa Rica, Patricia Thompson (Kevin) of Woodstock and Peter Buckle (Wanda) of Gainesville. He is also survived by brothers Edward of Ventura, Calif., Thomas of Bedminster, N.J. and Denis of Santa Clara, Calif. Mr. Buckle was born in Newark, N.J. on Jan. 26, 1928. He moved to Georgia in 1968 and later became the sole owner of Duffy Travel Inc. in Buckhead and later Roswell. He served as a chapter president of the American Society of Travel Agents (ASTA) and later was elected as a national director. He also served as the president of the International Association of Travel and Tourism Professionals (SKAL International). He served two years in the U.S. Marine Corp. during World War II and later attended Seton Hall University. He was a proud husband, father, grandfather of five and great-grandfather of two.
