Mr. James Ronnie Voight, 71, of Woodstock, Georgia passed away August 6, 2017 at his home surrounded by his loving family after a long battle with Parkinson's disease and Chronic Lymphatic Leukemia. He was a member of Mt. Bethel United Methodist Church and was a graduate of Georgia State University. Ronnie also served in the U.S. Marine reserves for 9 years and retired from UPS after a 34 year career.
