Jane Ann Byron-Goslin Age 58 of Hickory Flat, Georgia died July 3rd 2013 after a very brief struggle with cancer. She was a parishioner at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church.

Jane was born March 16TH 1955 to Frank and Ann Byron of Scranton, Pennsylvania. She was raised in Linwood, New Jersey and graduated from Mainland Regional High School in 1974. She attended Cooper Medical School of Nursing and became a registered nurse graduating at the top of her class with full honors. She began her medical career at Atlantic City Medical Center. Jane met her husband James M. Goslin (affectionately called Jim) and they wed on St. Patrick's Day March 17th, 1979. They moved to Georgia that year. They had three children: Abigail, Adam, Annie. During her career as a registered nurse, Jane worked for Northside Hospital for 25 years as an intensive/critical care nurse and most recently served as a case manager for Vitas Innovative Hospice. Jane touched countless lives with her love and compassionate care, she went above and beyond to help those in need whether she knew them or not. She worked tirelessly, always putting others first before her own needs. Janie was an artist, a teacher, a caregiver, a friend, a sister, a daughter, a beloved wife and mother.

She is survived by her loving husband Jim, of 34 years, and her children Abigail, Adam, Annie Byron-Goslin. Her mother Ann K. Byron. Preceded in
