Jarrot Arren Lindsey, Jr. age 91 of Sandy Springs passed away October 6, 2018 surrounded by his family. He was an Army veteran during WW II and was appointed the head up the chart drafting department for Nuremberg war crime trials in Germany. He graduated from Boys High School in Atlanta and went on to get a bachelor's degree in Journalism from Emory University then his Master's degree from the University of Alabama. He was the Director of Public Relations at Georgia State University until his retirement. In 1974 he began an antique business that he owned up until last week. He loved his country, spending time with his family and cheering on the Atlanta Falcons and the Braves. He was preceded in death by his grandson, Cory Chenggis; sisters and brothers-in-law, Louise and Charles "Scotty" Bruce and Lucy and George Smith. He is survived by his wife, Lee Lindsey of Sandy Springs; children, Margie and her husband Craig Chenggis of Alpharetta, Jarrot Alan Lindsey of Milton and Carole Mazzei of Roswell; grandchildren, Jake Mazzei, Cody Chenggis and Jamilee Mazzei; great-granddaughter, Kendall Mazzei; former son-in-law, Pete Mazzei and close family friend, Bettye Allen.
