Jean Cristofanelli, 97, of Roswell, Georgia went to be with her Heavenly Father on May 6, 2021. She was born Jean Marie Snider on January 16, 1924 in Pittsburgh, PA and grew up there. She married the love of her life, Joseph John Cristofanelli (Joe) in 1950, and they were blessed with four children, Lynn, Bill, Cindy and Wayne. Jean accepted Jesus as her Lord and Savior in 1961, and became instrumental in leading her entire family and her sister's family to make the same decision.
