Jenell Parker Hungerbuhler, 79, of Roswell, Georgia, passed away peacefully on February 16, 2026.

Born on February 23, 1946, in Pensacola, Florida, she was the daughter of the late John and Sarah Parker.

Jenell was a proud graduate of Turner County High School in Ashburn, Georgia, and earned her degree in English from Valdosta State College (now Valdosta State University) in Valdosta, Georgia.

A long-time member of Roswell United Methodist Church, she began her professional life with a brief tenure at C&S Bank in Atlanta, where she met her beloved husband, John Hungerbuhler. The couple married in April 1975 and shared 43 cherished years together until his passing.

Jenell embraced her calling as a stay-at-home mother, lovingly raising their four children: John Peter (Peter), Joan Marie (Joanie), Jennifer Lynn (Jenny), and Robert Thomas (Rob).
