“ *Jerry and I were classmates in high school (Scottsbluff, NE). Rather remarkably, we met again in St. Louis, Mo., in the early 1970's. As a Public Health Advisor for the Centers for Disease Control, US Public Health Service, I was assigned to the St. Louis City Health Dept.'s STD (VD back then) Program. I heard that the CDC assignee to the TB Prevention Program was named Jerry Hood. Probably a coincidence, I thought. After all, what are the chances that 2 guys coming out of the same high school class would end up in CDC and the same program? When I asked my supervisor where this Jerry Hood came from, he mentioned Nebraska. Could it be? Went to Jerry's office --- and there he was, the big smile and all. That was the beginning of a long friendship that lasted till his passing.*

Jerry and I discovered that we were kindred spirits in several areas. Three most prominent: progressive politics, Nebraska football and NCAA basketball. And while there are many memories involving these, probably our shared passion for basketball brings the biggest smile. We became big fans of the St. Louis University Billikins, going to many of their home games. And we were fortunate enough to get great tickets to the NCAA Final Four in 1973 being held in St. Louis. The four teams -- UCLA, Memphis, Providence and Indiana. Undefeated UCLA was simply unstoppable, with Bill Walton scoring 44 points (going 21 of 22 from the field) in the final against Memphis. Third place Indiana (they played a consolation game, back then) was coached by a young Bobby Knight.

Jerry was always passionate about all things in his life. The eternal optimist, he always found hope in areas where there only seemed to be despair. And he never seemed to lose that wonderful sense of humor, regardless of the situation. I will miss him. But I will never forget him.

My deepest sympathy to Betty and family. I hope your sorrow will fade and only the fondest memories of Jerry will be left in your hearts, bringing a 'Jerry' smile to your face.
