On October 23, 2018, Jesse Donald Durham passed into the presence of his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. “Doodle” was born at home in Alpharetta on April 4, 1940, to Joe and Jessie Durham. He lived most of his life in Alpharetta. Doodle met the love of his life, Barbara Jean DeVore at Milton High School in the mid-1950’s. During their senior year, Barbara was a cheerleader, while Doodle quarterbacked for the Milton Eagles. They were married on October 8, 1960, at First Baptist Church Alpharetta. Doodle worked for Southern Bell/AT&T for 29 years. He then worked as a painter and “fix it” man with his friend, Bob Brannon. He was a deacon for many years at FBC Alpharetta. Doodle loved sports, and spent much his adult life coaching little league baseball at Wills Park. Doodle was a loving husband, father, and grandfather. 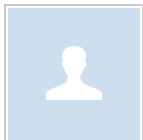
