Mr. John Timothy Donehoo, Sr., passed away Sunday, July 17, 2011. A native of Roswell, Mr. Donehoo was born September 2, 1928. He was the son of Rev. Ralph M. and Ethel Scott Donehoo and was preceded in death by brothers, Pat, Bill, Scott and Sam Donehoo. He was a long time member of the Roswell First Baptist Church where he was active in the choir and orchestra. He served as a pilot in the Air Force from 1951 to 1955. Mr. Donehoo was retired from the family business, the Roswell Seating Company. He was a great lover of music and the arts and was a self-taught trombonist, banjo player, fiddler, ukulele player and pianist. He was a constant encourager to his family members in their talents and interest. He is survived by his wife of 45 years, Peggy Paris Donehoo; sons, Dr. Paris N. Donehoo, John Timothy Donehoo, Jr.; daughters, Pamela Beard and Joy D. Guillebeau; sisters, Sarah D. Chapman and Frances D. Pressor; 10 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren. 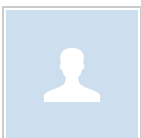
