Joseph (Joe) R. Wagner, 99, of Woodstock Ga, passed away peacefully on Sunday, February 14, 2021 surrounded by his loving family.

Joe was born on May 20, 1921 and raised in Pittsburgh, Pa where he met his wife, Ann. They married in 1943 while Joe was on Christmas leave prior to leaving for overseas duty.
