He came to America in political exile as part of the Peter Pan flights sponsored by the Jesuits. Juan attended Bloomfield College and had a 38-year career in hospital information systems. He retired 2 years ago which allowed him to enjoy his grandchildren and hobbies. Juan is survived by his wife, Graciela; his daughters Cristina Williams and Jennifer Friedman; and his 3 grandchildren Evan Williams and Henry and Charlie Friedman. The funeral Mass Will be celebrated at 2 p.m. on Wednesday, april 13 at St. Andrews Catholic Church, 675 Riverside Rd., Roswell.
