Julia Marie Barnes Clardy, (age 88) was born June 13, 1922, in Brownwood, Texas to Palmer and Victoreen Barnes. She spent her childhood in Brownwood within a loving family and graduated from Texas Women's University in Denton, Texas at the age of 19. Julia attended Brownwood High School at the same time as Len Clardy but they did not marry until March 24, 1947. Their first few years of marriage were spent in Spring Grove, PA and they returned to Houston, Texas to raise their family, son Alan and daughter Janet. In 1970 they relocated to Dunwoody, GA. and became active members of Dunwoody United Methodist Church. Their next move took them to the Crabapple area and then finally to Belmont Village.
