Julio "Jay" Batista passed away peacefully February 25, 2016. He was born 11/1/24 to Alfred and Maria Batista in Pawtucket, RI. Musically talented at an early age, he learned to play the violin, at which he became quite proficient, earning him statewide recognition. Along with the violin, he also played the trumpet, the latter which served to help him pay his way through college playing in swing bands. Though he eventually set down the trumpet, the violin, and music in general, stayed a passion for life. He graduated from Bryant College with a degree in accounting, and traveled to Indianapolis for his first job at Eli Lilly, where he met his future wife, Jane Strickland, the love of his life. They raised 3 children, with love, encouragement, happiness, and respect. He made a point of taking his family on trips most every year, with many wonderful adventures and travels throughout the US. He worked as an accountant for several companies in the Midwest, ending his career at the Illinois State Dept. of Agriculture in Springfield, IL, and retired to Hilton Head, SC, where he and his wife spent many years staying active and enjoying being close to the ocean. In a memorable 1983 trip, he and his brother John (and spouses) took their father Alfred on a driving tour of Portugal, the country of their ancestry. He was predeceased by his wife, Jane, in 2015, just short of their 68th wedding anniversary. He is survived by his brother John (Suzanne) Batista, son David (Emily) Batista, daughter Maria (Steve) Lamothe, and son Dr. Philip (Kasey) Batista, nephews Jay (Annette) Batista, Michael (Marcia) Batista and niece Elizabeth (James) Haines, as well as extended family
