Kate was a native of Woodstock, GA. She was a graduate of Milton High School in Alpharetta, GA and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She was employed as a literary assistant at Trident Media Group on Madison Avenue in New York.

Kate had an incredible sense of humor and an uncanny ability to enter a room and immediately make everyone feel better. She never met a stranger and threw herself enthusiastically into every undertaking. During her college days, she was a campus tour guide and admissions ambassador for new students and an intern at Algonquin Books in Chapel Hill. She completed an intensive, integrated study of Shakespeare at Oxford, U. K. through the UNC Honors Study Abroad program. Kate graduated with a double major in English and Art History.
