Katheryn (Katie) Kaple Hummel, 52, of Woodstock, GA, died, on Monday, September 26, 2022. Katie was born to Don and Marion Kaple on December 11, 1969 in Atlanta, GA. 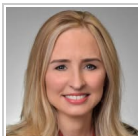
