Kelly Juan Bannevans, 43, of Johns Creek, GA passed away on Good Friday, April 6th, 2012 after a 6 and a half year battle with metastatic melanoma. She was born on August 1, 1968 in Pensacola, FL, but she had called the Atlanta area her home since 1995. Kelly was a graduate of the University of Alabama at Birmingham and had nearly completed her post-graduate degree at Vanderbilt University. She was a member of Peachtree Christian Church. Kelly had just celebrated her 9th wedding anniversary with her husband Packy on March 29th. She is survived by her son Garrett who will turn 6 on May 25th; her mother Jacqueline Sargent, sister Kim Sargent, and niece Hunter Hoover of Jay, FL; her father Charlie Sargent and his wife Phyllis of Crestview, FL and a larger extended family. The family will host a visitation from 6:00 to 8:00 PM at the Northside Chapel in Roswell on Easter Sunday.
