Kenneth Earle Nellums, Jr., age 61, of Woodstock, GA passed away February 27, 2015 "Kenny" was born in Chattanooga, TN on December 31, 1953 and grew up in Birmingham, AL. He graduated from Mountain Brook High School and attended Ole Miss and UAB. He worked at Southern Services Company as a drafting engineer for several years, but was able to utilize his artistic abilities as a designer at Clark Memorial. While there, he designed the bronze bust of Paul "Bear" Bryant that stands in front of Legion Field on a granite obelisk. He and his family moved to Atlanta in the late nineties, where he worked in restaurant management. He is survived by his wife of 32 years, Lucinda "Cindy" Mitchell Nellums; three daughters, Lucinda "Luci" Dale Nellums, Katherine "Katie" Louise Nellums, and Melissa Mitchell Nellums all of Woodstock; sister, Elizabeth Dale Nellums of Atlanta. A funeral service will be held Sunday at 5:00 Northside Chapel Funeral Directors in Roswell, GA with Brother Marty Smith officiating.
