



Mr. Larry William Garmon

June 24, 1943 - June 11, 2016

Larry William Garmon of Alpharetta, GA passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, June 11th, 2016 at North Fulton Hospital surrounded by his family and friends. Larry was a graduate of Milton High School, Class of 1961, and received the Journal Cup in 1961. He graduated from Georgia State University in 1965 and received his Master's degree from West Georgia College and Specialist's degree from the University of Georgia.

Larry married Barbara Hamrick in June 1963 and they celebrated their 52nd wedding anniversary in 2015. They had two children, Melanie Goldstone and Wade Garmon. Larry worked as a teacher, counselor, and administrator for 32 years at Roswell High School and Haynes Bridge Middle School. Larry also spent many years working at several local banks. He served as a Sunday School teacher and Deacon at First Baptist Church of Alpharetta. He was also a member of the Alpharetta & Old Milton County Historical Society.

Larry was a highly respected and loved member of the Alpharetta community. He will be tremendously missed by all who knew him. Larry was preceded in death by his parents, E.S. "Lefty" and Margarite Duncan Garmon. He is survived by his wife, Barbara Hamrick Garmon; sister Janice Tarpley; daughter, Melanie Goldstone, and granddaughters Carly and Amber; son, Wade Garmon and wife Jennifer, and granddaughters Katie and Olivia.

Visitation will be held at Northside Chapel in Roswell from 2-4 and again from 6-8 on Monday, June 13th. The memorial service will be held at First Baptist Church Alpharetta at 3:00 on Tuesday, June 14th. The family will also receive

visitors at the church from 2-3 prior to the service.

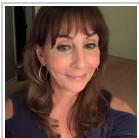
