



Mrs. Lena C. McGuyer

June 9, 1935 - November 26, 2022

On Friday, Nov. 25, Lena Margaret Carlson McGuyer, passed away peacefully in her sleep. She was 87 years old. She moved to Alpharetta, Ga., from Mineral Wells, Texas, in 2005 after Charles McGuyer, her husband of 42 years, preceded her in death.

Lena was born on June 9, 1935, in Thermopolis, Wyo. She was an active member of Alpharetta First United Methodist Church, where she volunteered time in the church's Blanket Ministry. In addition, Lena participated in many activities at the Alpharetta Senior Center, including tai chi classes and the Golden Age Club.
