



## Lewis Taylor Brady, Jr.

December 26, 1928 - September 20, 2012

Lewis “Lew” Taylor Brady, Jr., 83, of Roswell, GA, passes away September 20, 2012, in Atlanta, after battling a long-term illness due to sustained war injuries.

Vigil services will be held on Monday, September 24 from 6 until 8 p.m. at Northside Chapel Funeral Directors, 12050 Crabapple Rd., Roswell. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Tuesday, September 25 at 10:00 a.m. at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church, 535 Rucker Rd., Alpharetta. Fr. Austin Fogarty and Deacon Kevin Tracy will serve as celebrants.

He was born in Louisville, KY on the day after Christmas, 1928. He attended Catholic elementary school, entered a prep seminary in Bardstown, KY and later graduated from the University of Louisville with a degree in Business Administration. Thereafter, he was inducted into the U.S. Army and served as a tank commander, and was honorably discharged as a disabled veteran. Lew is preceded in death by his father, Lewis Taylor Brady, Sr. and mother, Annabelle Steier; sisters, Marie Vivian and Julie “Judy”; brother, Robert “Bobbie” and son Gary Bruce.

Lew is survived by his wife, Lynn; daughters, Tammy, Diana, Karen and Claudia; sons, John and Dana; grandchildren, Tea, Cooper, TJ, Kristen, Susanne, Catherine, Robert, Amy and Cory; great-grandchildren, Taylor and Trenton.

Lew was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, patriot, successful businessman and man of faith who left his family a legacy of love and

laughter. He served his country with honor and dignity and was decorated with a Bronze Star, medal of Korea and National Defense Service medal.

He served his church and community as an Honorary 3rd, Knight of Columbus and commissioned Kentucky colonel by the Governor of the Commonwealth of KY.

He loved hunting, fishing, golfing, music, playing cards, gardening, and going on trips to the ocean with his lovely wife and family.

He will be entombed in the chapel mausoleum at Green Lawn Cemetery in Roswell following the mass. A reception for family and friends will follow in the fellowship hall at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church.
