



## Louise Kemp Beavers

July 3, 1931 - July 3, 2012

Lydia Louise Kemp Beavers, 81, of Alpharetta passed away at her home on July 3, 2012 after an extended battle with Parkinson's disease and more recently with Multiple Myeloma. She was born on July 3, 1931 in the Lost Mountain community of West Cobb County. Her parents were the late James and Estelle (Turner) Kemp. She attended McEachern High School and graduated from the University of Georgia with a degree in Home Economics in 1952. Louise began her career as a home demonstration agent with the Cooperative Extension Service in Cherokee County. She moved to Alpharetta in 1954, where she taught home economics at both Milton and Roswell High Schools. She also taught kindergarten for 20 years at the private Virginia Gay Kindergarten. Louise was a member of Alpharetta First United Methodist Church for 58 years. She served in many ministries of the church and was instrumental in beginning the church preschool. She will be remembered for her faith, her love of family and friends, and her beautiful flowers. She is an Honorary Lifetime member of the Alpharetta Garden Club and a member of the Alpharetta Historical Society. She was preceded in death by her husband, Carrol M. Beavers, Sr. She is survived by her children Carrol Jr. and Virginia Beavers, of Madison County, GA and Lydia and Gary Black of Commerce, GA; grandchildren Blake Beavers, St. Simons Island, Brett Beavers, Alpharetta, Ward Black, Athens, GA, Caroline Black, College Station, TX, Kelsey Beavers, Nashville, TN, and Josh Huff, Cleveland; and brother Dennis and Frances Kemp of Marietta, GA.
