Lydia Adelaide Olguin Fitzgerald, 86 of Canton died December 2, 2011. Lydia was born in Littleton, CO but spend most of her childhood in Moab, UT. In 1945 she married Charles F. Fitzgerald of Sandy Springs, GA. She worked for Fulton County School Food Services for 32 years until her retirement in 1983. The last school she worked at was Crestwood High School in Roswell, GA where she was known as “Mom” to the student body, faculty and staff. Upon retirement she began her next chapter in life volunteering at North Fulton Charities Clothes Closet for 21 years. For more than 50 years, she was a faithful and active member of Roswell United Methodist Church. Mrs. Fitzgerald was preceded in death by her husband of 66 years, Charles F. Fitzgerald. She is survived by her children and their spouses, Beverly and Garry Holton of Canton, Julie and Jim Keeter of Alpharetta, Judy and Rick Lewis of Covington and Richard and Kris Fitzgerald of Stone Mountain; sister, Mae Kopp of Idaho; 10 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren; beloved nephew, Michael Olguin.
