



Mrs. Margaret Hazel Baggett Williams

May 11, 1917 - May 9, 2014

Hazel, as she was called by her many friends, and Mama by her grand and great-grandchildren passed away quietly at her residence May 9, 2014. She was one of 16 children born in Graceville, FL to Jefferson Davis Baggett and Rhoda Elizabeth Grant Cartledge Baggett. In 1938 she married her beloved husband, Charlie Bee Williams, and in 1949 moved to Columbus, GA; she resided there until 2005 when moving to assisted living in Roswell, Georgia.

Hazel's life mirrored that of many of her "Greatest Generation" peers: her family lost its farm during the Great Depression; she raised her young children while her husband was fighting in World War II; she moved her family after the war in search of a better life; and she resolutely provided for her family no matter what the trials. Her first loves were her family and God. Her third was gardening - she always had the most beautiful flower beds and vegetable garden which friends and strangers would stop just to view.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her siblings, and her loving husband of 56 years. She is survived by her four children and their spouses – Charlie Baggett Williams and Joyce Vining Williams of Columbus, GA, Hazel Ruth Williams Pope and Walter Mashburn Pope, Jr, of Franklin, NC, C. Linwood Williams and Mattie Sue Richburg Williams of Sunset, SC, and Jerry Michael Williams and Marian Whitt Williams of Alpharetta, GA – her twelve grandchildren, and nineteen great-grandchildren.
