Roswell, GA resident Mary Christina Lovinggood Anfinson, known as “Christy” throughout her life, died suddenly in her home on Wednesday, September 18, 2019.

Christy was born July 18, 1971, in Atlanta, GA to Charles and June Lovinggood.

She had an uncommon and heavenly gift as a singer; her gifts were recognized at an early age. She studied voice performance on scholarship at William Carey University in Hattiesburg, MS, performing with their award-winning choir and exceling in solo and ensemble work.
