She had the unique experience to visit every country in the world and had a collection of items from each country. She was stationed in Panama during the conflict Operation Just Cause in 1989. After Mary's retirement she moved to Woodstock, GA. Mary became a member of Lebanon Baptist Church where she was very active until her health began to decline three years ago.
