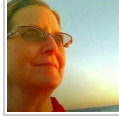

We love and miss you so much Mary!

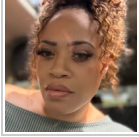

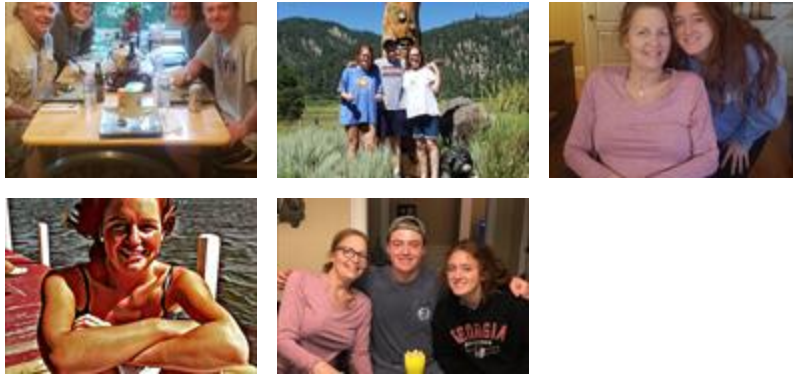
