



Maxine Mull Carlisle

November 17, 1927 - June 22, 2022

(Bonnie) Maxine Mull Carlisle was born November 17, 1927, in Reynoldsville, Illinois to E. O. Mull and Vida Albright Mull. Maxine passed away on Wednesday, June 22, 2022. They moved to Anna, Illinois when she was five years old, and that was her home until 1949. She became a Christian when she was eleven years old, was baptized and joined the First Baptist Church in Anna, and was very active in church activities. She attended Southern Illinois University for one year, after which she became a professional model in Chicago in 1949.

Maxine married Roy T. Carlisle on October 15, 1949 at the first Baptist Church in Anna, and they later made their home in Maroa, Illinois, then St. Louis, and finally Atlanta. She gave birth to a son, Stephen R. Carlisle, on March 11, 1952 in Decatur, Illinois; and a daughter, Cherie Diane Carlisle, April 4, 1955 in Decatur. They later moved to St. Louis, Missouri, where a daughter, Christi Marlene Carlisle, was born on November 16, 1963. They moved to Atlanta in 1970, where Maxine has spent the rest of her life. She was employed as Administrative Assistant to the president of Georgia Hospitality and Travel Association in Atlanta for several years. Maxine was married to Roy for 24 years. Twelve years later, December 5, 1987, she married James H. Scarborough at the Wieuca Road Baptist Church in Atlanta. They were married for 22 years until his passing. She has been a member of Lebanon Baptist church in Roswell, Georgia since 1988.

Preceding Maxine in death were her mother, Vida Albright Mull McIntire and

step-father, Glenn McIntire; father E.O. Mull; precious grandson, Joshua Harmon; daughter, Cherie Carlisle Harmon; first husband, Roy T. Carlisle; second husband, James H. Scarborough. Survivors are her son and daughter-in-law, Steve and Debbie Carlisle; daughter, Marlene Carlisle; grandchildren, John and wife Stephanie Carlisle, Jeremy Carlisle, Michelle and husband Robert Binion, Denver Hullender; great-grandchildren, Maxwell Carlisle, Cameran Carlisle, Elizabeth Binion, Robert (Beau) Binion, Sailem Hullender.
