December 20, 1968 - May 12, 2011

Michael W. Kolesar, age 42 of Canton, died May 12, 2011 from stage IV stomach cancer at his home, surrounded by family and friends. Michael was born at Camp Pendleton, CA in 1968 to Joseph and Dagmar Kolesar. In 1980, the Kolesar family moved to Gainesville, GA, where Michael excelled in high school sports, earning the distinction of Captain and MVP of both the Gainesville High School football and baseball teams his senior year in 1987. That same year, Michael played in the American Legion World Series in Deland, FL, with the Gainesville American Legion Post 7 Baseball team.

He attended college at the University of Mississippi, where he earned a Bachelor of Business Administration in Economics in 1991 and an MBA in 1992, as well as a Master of Science in Health Administration from the University of Alabama at Birmingham in 1994, earning a Graduate Certificate in Gerontology.

Michael served as a Practice Administrator for American Anesthesiology of Georgia for ten years, and since 2009, he served as Practice Administrator and Chief Executive for Northside Radiology Associates.

Michael's passion was spending time with his family and friends, and watching Ole Miss football. He was an assistant coach for his sons Preston and Ryan's baseball teams from the time they were six and seven years old.

Michael is survived by his wife of 16 years, Kimberly Wilborn Kolesar; three sons; Preston (11), Ryan (10) and John David (4); parents, Joseph and Dagmar Kolesar of Gainesville, GA; grandmother, Edith Hebler of Gainesville, GA; and four aunts, Diane Hebler of Cumming, GA, Beatrix McGee of Boone, NC, Dr. Pat Knod of Chicago, IL, and Carol Hammond of Pittsburgh, PA.
