



## Mildred Vanderhoof Glenn

November 22, 1913 - August 25, 2009

MILDRED VANDERHOOF (LEAVITT) GLENN - Mildred Glenn 95 of Alpharetta, GA died peacefully at the home of her daughter on August 25, 2009. She was born on November 22, 1913, and raised in Asheville, NC. She was the daughter of the late Arnold H. and Marion Almy Vanderhoof. She resided in Dublin from 1956 to 1992. While living in Dublin she was an active member of Dublin First Baptist Church, the Dublin Service League, and the Women's Study Club. She was a volunteer at Fairview Park Hospital and the Mental Health Center in Dublin. She was named Dublin's Woman of the Year in 1970.

After leaving Dublin she resided at Wesley Woods Towers in Atlanta, GA for twelve years. While at the Towers, she taught the resident Sunday School Class and led an art class for the residents of Budd Terrace. She moved to Alpharetta, GA in 2004.

Mrs. Glenn was preceded in death by her first husband, Halsey Brown Leavitt, Jr. She is survived by their four children: Halsey Brown Leavitt, III (Sharon) of Milledgeville, GA; Marion Almy Leavitt (Pam) of Atlanta, GA; Tish Leavitt Beall (Emmitt) of Alpharetta, GA; and Millie Leavitt Nafziger (Tim) of Greenville, SC. 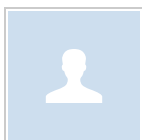
