Mitchell Scott Manley was born on May 20, 1992 at Northside Hospital in Atlanta, GA. Mitchell attended schools in and around Roswell until the beginning of the sophomore year at Roswell High School. He then transferred to Northwest Academy in Naples, Idaho and graduated in December 2010. He moved back to Georgia, lived a short time in Athens before returning home to Roswell and finally moving to Nashville, Tennessee in January 2015. Mitch worked at Sam's Club in Nashville. He remained a resident until his death on January 13, 2016.

Mitchell is survived by his parents, Scott and Cindi Manley, his older brother Jackson and his wife, Angela, who reside in Severn Maryland.
