



Mr. Nadathur "Jay" Jayaraman

July 1, 1936 - March 14, 2018

A service will be held at Northside Chapel Funeral Directors on Saturday, March 17, 2018 at 6:30pm. The family will receive friends from 5:00pm to 6:30pm.

Affectionately known as Jay, "Jay" Nadathur Sadhu Jayaraman passed away on 14th March 2018. Jay lived in the Atlanta area, in Roswell, for the last 26 years.

Jay was born in India on 1st July 1936, the sixth of eight children of N.S. Varadachari and Kanakavalli. Jay studied in Chennai India, and studied Engineering at the Madras Institute of Technology. After graduating, he worked for a few years at Hindustan Aeronautics in Bangalore, India. He married Indira Jayaraman in 1964, and the couple emigrated to Montreal, Canada, with their first daughter Rekha, in 1966. In Montreal, Jay worked at Canadair, in the field of Avionics. Their second daughter Meera was born in 1969. The family lived in Montreal until 1976, and then relocated to Los Angeles. Jay transitioned to a new role at Lockheed Martin, and spent the rest of his long and distinguished career at Lockheed, contributing on various complex avionics projects on advanced aircraft defence and surveillance systems. The family moved to the Atlanta area in 1991, and Jay continued his work at the Lockheed headquarters in Marietta, until his retirement in 1999, at the age of 63. After his retirement, Jay contributed his time as a volunteer with the Red Cross, helping on various projects, including recovery efforts in the

aftermath of 9/11 in New York, and following the devastation of Hurricane Katrina.

He spent his later years in peace, with the joy of participating in the lives of his wife, his daughter and her husband, and his three beautiful grandchildren. Jay was unique and special, brilliant and accomplished at work, incredibly humble and modest, generous, caring and giving to family, friends and the community.

Jay is survived by his wife Indira Jayaraman, their daughter Meera Warren and her husband Michael Warren and their children Michael, Lance and Andrew, as well his surviving sibling Soundara, and many relatives living in various parts of the world, who love him deeply and will miss him.
