Neil McClusky, of Milton, GA, passed away on January 3, 2016 at the age of 52. Originally from the San Francisco Bay Area, Neil moved his wife and children to Atlanta 4 years ago for a job opportunity with Cox Automotive. As the Voice Systems Manager for Cox Automotive, he was responsible for all telephony operations, including wireless, call centers, and campus support. Neil was a parishioner of St. Brigid Catholic Church in Johns Creek, GA, and a proud member of the Knights of Columbus, Council 13204. He was a beloved husband and father who loved spending time with his family, especially his 5 boys.

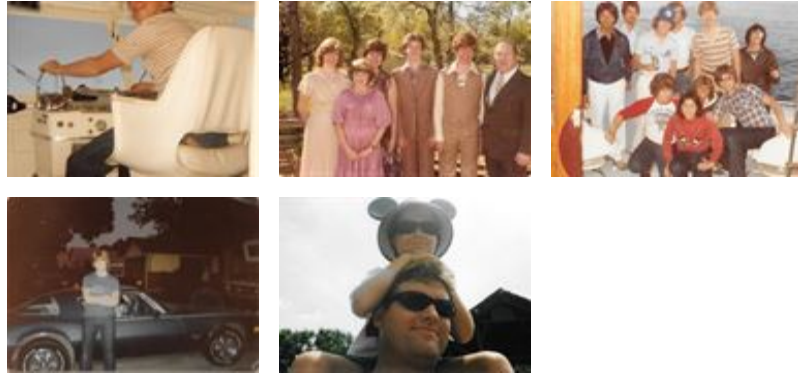
