Paul Arlo Scholfield, 81, of Milton, Georgia passed away Wednesday, November 16, 2022. Paul was born on January 12, 1941 in Freeport, Illinois, to the late Keith Rawlings Scholfield and Mary Denton Simmons Scholfield. He was raised in Moline, Illinois, where his Dad was an engineer for John Deere Corporation.
